New responsive behavior concept

This theme is permanently responsive; from 185 to 1850pxl the theme is constantly changing in this length.

For the first time a theme with two 4 columns: Toolbar + Content + column 1 + column 2.

The first column is made with extracontent and the second columns is the regular RW sidebar. No external plugins required to use 2 columns. In the DMG you can find a demo project.

Minimax allow you ti build a great site if you use Stack plugin and some responsive Stacks. With Minimax+Stack you can build a professional theme.

The theme run smoothly on major browser and internet explorer 8/9/10.

Features version 1.2: Fixed issue in the Stack Page using "Contact form Stack" by DooBox. Added new font style "courier".

System Requirement: RapidWeaver 5 and above

Note to Installation Themes:

A: Open Compress folder with Double click and open the theme folder

B: Double click on the theme itself, as example your MultiThemes.rwtheme.

C: Then you will find the theme in theme list in RapidWeaver (command + alt + t)

C2: You can also install manually in: Your home/user > Library > Application Support > Rapidweaver

Note: If you want to modify the theme Make a backup copy of original theme or use "Duplicate your theme" option, available in the themes list.

Disclaimer: Our themes are carefully crafted and are made to reduce compatibility issues to a minimum.

Themes work flawlessly in:

Mac/Pc: Safari FireFox Chrome Opera are supported with themes features / Pc: Internet Explorer 8+ FireFox Chrome Opera / Support for iPad/tablets and iPhone/Smartphones

Compatibility specs: Once again, the compatibility of CSS files had to be limited to the most modern and frequently used browsers.

Being compatible with Internet Explorer 8 for Windows required the harder work. Multithemes structure view is correct with all browsers, though small details (like frame width or font size) may change with some of them. Such changes depend strictly upon the browser used, and do not affect the page structure or content readability.

This theme and jQuery: To preserve our themes' advanced functionalities, we name-spaced all the theme's internal javascript so that our latest -and compatible with the theme's- jQuery version is used without, hopefully, any conflict with any other jQuery declaration (i.e. jQuery from plugins, stacks, etc.). That will increase the theme compatibility virtually with any third party javascript library. Finally, we set the theme's jQuery declaration to use Google CDNs to provide blazing fast loading times but with a gracefully degradation fallback call to the same library, locally, so that you will able to edit your theme even if not online.

CSS3, HTML5 and (guess who?) Internet Explorer: Internet Explorer doesn't support some CSS3 advanced features. We implemented those features with gracefully degradation in mind so that you will get it well rendered but with some minimal differences. IE9 and IE10 support is really high though.

We suggest you to turn ON the "Consolidate CSS files" in this theme

CSS consolidation can be turned on by clicking RapidWeaver in the menu bar and clicking Preferences in the menu. Click onto the Publishing tab and tick the Consolidate CSS Files option.

With this option activated you can save time for the browser reading. This can result in reduced publishing times and also pages which load faster.

This option allows you to avoid in some cases issues in Stacks pages (pages with several stacks inside).

Of significant importance is that some web browsers like Internet Explorer 8 impose a strict 30 stylesheet limit, so CSS consolidation enables you to safely circumvent this limit. If you need a compatibility with IE8 you "must" use the CSS consolidation.

In the RapidWeaver preferences you can also turn on an option called "Compress CSS files". In reality this setting only shaves off a couple of kilobytes. The CSS code is compressed in such a way that it can no longer be read easily by humans. CSS Consolidation is the most important one to have switched on.

Codes: JQuery library is included in this theme. The latest HTML5 and CSS3 standards. CSS3 animation for each Built-in Page.

Responsive Options:



A MINIMAX theme with built-in support for iPad / tablets / iPhone / Smartphone

This theme was planned to work from small phones to large screen.

The break point from classic layout to responsive layout is 719px. However, every width comes with adjustments to improve the navigation.

Every Built-in Page of RapidWeaver has been improved and not only in the responsive version.

The responsive environment works well on all major browser on the Mac and PC, including Internet Explorer 9. We've added some extra instructions for each browser. We've also added some codes for Internet Explorer 8 if you need a compatibility with this old browser (in this case you must turn ON the "CSS consolidation files" in RW pref.).

Note: You must make a preview of your project to see the theme in responsive mode on your browser (resize the browser window to see the theme in action).

Moreover, we suggest to use a real iPad/iPhone device for your tests; in this case you must publish the entire project on the web.

Responsive layout: The theme is permanently responsive from 185 (very small phones) to 1850 pixels (large screen and television).

Expanded Toolbar: If this option is turned on the responsive version of the site (max 700px) starts with the navigation menu opened.

Responsive version of the Toolbar:

Due to the inline navigation design, there's 3 levels of sub navigation per parent page.

Font Size: in this theme you can choose a different Size for large screen or smartphones. the font size is based on 16px

Presponsive options:

Hide Sidebar Title in SmartPhones

Intelligent text size:

Increase Text in SmartPhones: +20% text size, from 185px to 500px.

We've added also some codes for Televisions: +20% text size, widths 1023px + 1279px + 1919px , and televisions with aspect-ratio: 16/9.

Responsive Image with intelligent altTAG: "image " (image + "space" if you have text in the altTAG)

You can enable, selectively, per each image where you'll need it, the "fluid" responsive behavior.

It means that the image will adapt in width (keeping its ratio with its height) to its content, by just adding the keyword "image " at the beginning of the alt text.

Note: If in preview mode your image looks pixelated, try either setting the scale to 100%, or use a larger version of the image; the right size depend on the theme layout.

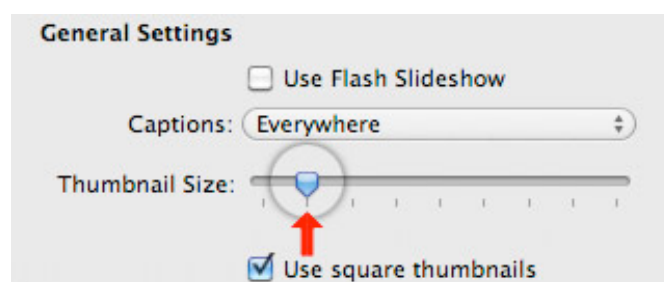

Responsive Photo Album:

To show correctly the photo album RapidWeaver page set the thumbnails as the picture below.

Open the Option Panel and choose the second size.

This page is optimized for this thumbnails size because is quite good for small devices. If you don't need the responsive layout ignore this warning.



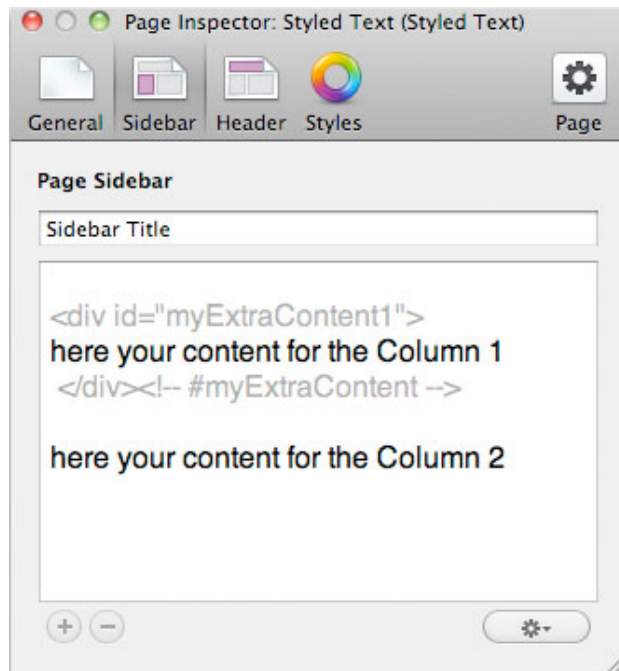
EXTRACONTENT:

the Column n1 of this theme is made with Extracontent “1”.

1: Default usage without external plugin:

When you start with a new project you must put this code in the sidebar for the “extracontent1” (the first column). Default code (not used in stacks):

<div id="myExtraContent1">here your content for the Column 1</div><!-- #myExtraContent -->

2: With Stack plugin (<http://www.yourhead.com/stacks/>) + Extracontent Stack

If you use Stack Plugin as a default page you can use the Extracontent stack instead. The ExtraContent Stack allows you to drag your content into the ExtraContent area of your choice without the need for code. Simply add the ExtraContent Stack to your page, set the ExtraContent number in the HUD, then add your content inside it. Anything you add will appear in the designated ExtraContent area.

Drag the E- stack in your page and drag inside this stack your content.

in the stack panel you must choose the extracontent number.

in this theme 1=First sidebar, 2=Bottom page, 3=top page

Some info about Extracontent:

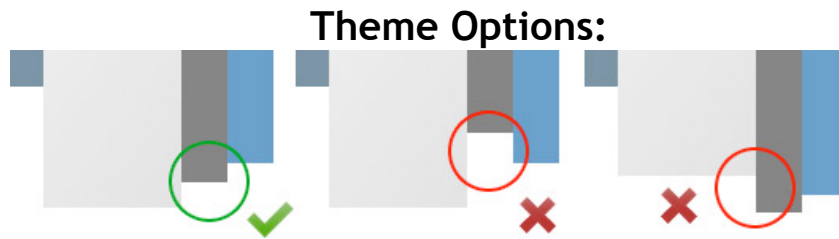
The Extracontent Option (1 fixed and 2 panels on/off) is an external free addition. ExtraContent came about when a handful of 3rd party developers got together to address the need for more content spaces in RapidWeaver. While the content area and sidebar are ample space for the vast majority of RapidWeaver users, there are some who want more flexibility to add content in ways keeping with today's modern web designs. To use Extracontent you may use some snippets, it is easy.

This plugin allows you to import stacks from one page into another page and/or in Extracontent.



make sure to create a project with columns with correct length. The page must be the first element, after the column1 and column 2. The best layout of Minimax requires Extracontent2 activated (the bottom page)

Colours Options: you can edit also the colour of some styles in this theme:
Text, links, page/content/body.

Height Header: 2 images + 2 shades + Transparent + Off (hide header).

Line: you can choose 3 sizes of thickness and color.
note: if the header is turned Off the Line is not available.

Skin page (Page Style): you can choose the color.

Toolbar Styles: 4 toolbar styles (horizontal and vertical) + the responsive toolbar @700px for small devices.

Background: 6 tiled images.

back to Top: located at the left/bottom side with arrow.

Columns: Column 1 (extracontent1) + Column 2 (the sidebar)

Extracontent top/bottom: On/Off (show / hide)
Extracontent 2 and 3 with 2 images + Transparent + No images.

Photo Album: Classic album with new page style or with Slideshow through prettyphoto.

Width: Responsive 185/1850px
Every width was planned to fit the site in iPad and iPhone (landscape and portrait).

Logo: Logo is available for this theme. (200x65 pixel).
You can turn off the logo (or the Viewing button) at 240px, 320px, 480px.

Title: you can choose the font and the color.

Body Fonts + Font navigation: Lucida Grande, Helvetica, Trebuchet MS, Georgia, arial.

Text options:

Text Justification for Page, column 1+2 and Extracontent 2+3.

Toolbar text Uppercase

Extra Content 3 (on top): turn off all padding/margin). Useful for responsive slideshow, With this option turned ON the image can fit to the window width

Text size:

Default based on 16px

Decrease (-20%), increase (+ 20%) ,increase +15% after 1400px

In this case @1400px the text grow automatically.

note: in the "responsive option" you can find further text options (for Small and big devices)

WebFonts: 11 WebFonts for titles and classes + 10 for the toolbar.

Select the WebFont in the Options Panel. Add the class before and after your text : <h1> Your text >/h1>

(available for: H6, h5, h4, h3, h2, h1)

Social icons: small size + button styles + big size + big size2 (with dark shadow)

in this theme you can show your favorite social link.

59 different icons styled as animated buttons/colors. Easy setup (read below).

Add your favorite social icon:

To create social links copy and paste the codes (below) into your project.

- Replace # with the url to the social network

- Note: You must apply the "Ignore Formatting" to the selected code.

The option is located in the RapidWeaver toolbar: "Format / Ignore Formatting".

You can paste the code in the Page, in the sidebar and also in the Extracontent.

F

is the URL and F is the social icon; in this case F = Facebook
